



- declare all goods being temporarily imported (including equipment and personal effects), and be prepared to provide a written list of such goods including relevant values, and
- export all temporarily-imported goods within a reasonable time after the completion of your event.

Please note that these provisions do not preclude any Customs examination that may be deemed appropriate at the time of entry. It is recommended that importers not familiar with importing procedures are made aware of the Automated Customs Information Service, available at 1-800-461-9999.

It should be noted that items 38 and 41 provide for temporary importations only. It would follow that consumables and any articles which are to be given away or sold in Canada may be subject to the regular tariff provisions at the time of importation (i.e. the applicable duties and/or taxes are paid on a B3 - Canada Customs Coding Form). In this regard, it has been decided that consumables (e.g. fuel in excess of the normal tank capacity, oil, grease) which are to be used in the course of racing in this event and which accompany the participants, will not require documentation; as well as the "fan" cards which are imported for free distribution by the drivers.

Participants may wish to register their goods with U.S. Customs in order to expedite their return after the event.

Transport Canada advises that, under their regulations, no additional documentation will be required for the racing vehicles entering Canada on a temporary basis.

Proof of citizenship (birth certificate/passport) is required of all persons entering Canada, in accordance with Canadian Immigration regulations.
